

The Skowhegan History House Kiosk is surrounded by the golden RUDBECKIA LACINIATA (Asteraceae) and the pink HIBISCUS MOSCHEUTOS, (Malvaceae).

Both are native perennials. The Rudbeckia laciniata is also known as Golden Glow, Thimble Flower, or Coneflower and had its earliest American citation in Philadeplhia, 1804. The Hibiscus moscheutos is also known as Mallow, Swamp Rose, Rose Mallow, or Wild Cotton. Its earliest American citation was Bartram, Philadelphia 1783.
