The Skowhegan History House was founded in 1936 by Louise Helen Coburn to house archival, artifact, photography, and library collections pertaining to the culture and early life in Skowhegan, Maine.

The Regina Music Box is one of Skowhegan History House's prized pieces dating to 1892. The music box is hand cranked and plays compositions from large, thin metal disks. Each disk has a series of punch outs that the music box transcribes into melodious notes.

This CD contains 18 familiar compositions of the nineteenth century.
